Subject: Gilbarco One Touch Canada (OTC) Training Now Available

Please note that the Gilbarco training department has released the **online training course for One Touch Canada (OTC).**

The only prerequisite for this course is GVR Fueling Site Safety certification – HOWEVER – **to get paid for an OTC call a technician must have three (3) valid certifications** – **Fueling Site Safety, Canadian Dispensing Systems and OTC Training Video. The primary technician on site must have all three certifications**. Technicians who are assisting (helper techs) need only Fueling Site Safety and the OTC training video.

The course is available on the "Self-enrollment" tab in the LMS (the WISE site – http://wise.gilbarco.com). When you log in select "Self-enrollment", then "One Touch Canada (2013)" and click the icon on the top left of the window. This will add it to the "Canada" options along the left side of the LMS screen under "Main Menu". The course will then be available for you to complete. Please see the attached document "One Touch Canada (OTC) Course Self-Enrollment" for further enrollment details.

There is no charge for the OTC Training Video course. There is a quiz following the video, technicians must answer all ten (10) questions correctly in order to receive certification on the OTC Training Video. The 10 questions will be randomly pulled from a pool of 20 questions. Technicians will be allowed three (3) attempts to answer all 10 questions correctly. All answers to the questions are found throughout the video, therefore you must watch the entire video to prepare for the test and the OTC program.

Technicians should be able to complete this training video course in approximately 40 minutes.

This OTC certification will expire in one year from the date of issue. The OTC program will be starting in August 2013 so please access this course as soon as possible to receive your certification. If you have any questions please submit them to technicaltraining@gilbarco.com

How to self-enroll in the One Touch Canada (2013) course


- 1. Log onto the WISE site (http://wise.gilbarco.com)
- 2. Select the "Self-enrollment" tab along the top of the screen:



The Gilbarco Training Department has released a training video to familiarize an ASC Technician with the OTC process.

The course itself does not require a pre-requisite other than SAFETY; however, to get paid for an OTC Call, you must have 3 certifications (Safety, Dispenser & OTC Training Video). The primary technician onsite **must have** all 3 certifications. Technicians assisting (helper techs) only need Safety & the OTC Training Video Course.

The course is available on the Self-enrollment tab in LMS. When you log in, select Self-enrollment, then select One Touch Canada (2013), then click the icon to add this course to "My courses".



There is no charge for the OTC Training Video Course.

A quiz will follow the video. The technician must answer all 10 questions correctly in order to receive certification on the OTC Training Video.
